New Testament FORGIVENESS comes out of God's GRACE

1 of 4 Greek words used in New Testament for FORGIVENESS

charizomai (Strong's #G5483) khar-id'-zom-ahee

- Has a meaning of to FREELY GIVE
- Related to charis (Strong's #G5485) the Greek word for GRACE

To those FORGIVEN in Christ, FORGIVENESS relates to your new nature, in Christ, to be FORGIVING:

- Colossians 3:13 translated as FORGIVING
- Ephesians 4:32 translated as FORGIVING and FORGAVE
- 2 Corinthians 2:10 translated as FORGIVE and FORGIVEN
- Colossians 2:13 translated as FORGIVEN
- Luke 7:42 translated as FREELY FORGAVE
- Romans 8:32 translated as FREELY GIVE
